ManorCon XXX 20th to 23rd July 2012

Stamford Hall, University of Leicester

The organization for ManorCon XXX is proceeding well. If you haven't booked yet, remember that you can do so in two ways. You can book online via PayPal or a credit or debit card – visit http://www.manorcon.org.uk/book.htm and follow the links. Or you can still post a form and cheque – the form can be found at the same place if you need one. Please remember that **advance registration is only available until 16th June.** After this, you will have to register at the door and pay higher registration fees and accommodation charges (and you may not get any accommodation at all – our supply of rooms is fairly limited).

If you have booked, but need to cancel all or some of your booked accommodation, you should inform us as soon as possible. If you cancel by the booking deadline, then you will definitely avoid cancellation charges. Thereafter, the later you leave it to inform us, the more likely you are to suffer accommodation cancellation charges.

ManorCon is run by volunteers, and does not aim to make a profit. In order for us to keep this tradition, we ask for volunteers for a number of tasks. One of these is help with the registration desk, usually by manning the desk for an hour on the Friday afternoon. Now that we hand out keys in addition to handling onthe-door bookings, we need lots of volunteers! If anybody asks anything you don't know, just point them at the nearest committee member – it's not difficult. If you would like to help us out and failed to mention it when booking, please email us at regdesk@manorcon.org.uk.

This year, as usual, we will have a mix of scheduled and ad-hoc tournaments, plus some other competitions and events.

Scheduled tournaments:

Croquet – knock-out tournament limited to a maximum of 16 players.

Diplomacy – individual rounds at 1800 on Friday, 1000 on Saturday, and 1000 on Sunday. In addition to the main tournament, there is also the **Diplomacy Challenge**, an individual one round tournament based solely on scores in the Saturday round. This replaces the team round from previous years.

Midnight Party – three rounds, at midnight each evening.

UKF2FDip.org presents Kent-Kon, the brand new entry into the world of face-to-face tournament diplomacy and the first step of the Tour of Britain 2012.

Between Friday 13th & Sunday 15th April 2012, we will play 3-4 games of Diplomacy. The first round will begin at 7pm Friday evening and the tournament will conclude on Sunday afternoon. There will be a Saturday morning and Saturday afternoon round, with Saturday evening free for attendees to enjoy a meal out and/or to play other games.

Accommodation will be available for Friday and Saturday evening. You don't need to attend the whole tournament to participate. The emphasis is very much on inclusivity and promoting the hobby, especially to new players. The Kon will take place at Benenden School, Cranbrook Road, Kent TN17 4AA.

The nearest train station is Staplehurst which is on a direct line from Charing Cross and Ashford International. A taxi to the Kon is about £18. However, we plan to run cars between the station and the venue if several players plan arrive/depart at roughly same time.

The event will require a £20 payment via paypal to cover tournament fees, accommodation and food. We may run an honesty box for snacks and drinks etc. Yes that's right, single room accommodation is included in the price!
